PUBLIC HEARING ON THE EAST AFRICAN COMMUNITY CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2022

The EALA Committee on Communicate, Trade and Investment is scheduled to undertake public hearings with stakeholders on the aforementioned Bill in the Partner States on **18th to 21st September 2022.** The main objective of the public hearings is to provide an avenue for stakeholders to have their inputs in the legislative process of the East African Community.
